

SUPERSTRUCTURE

Lengthwise, the superstructure changes fluently into a teardrop form and is as smooth and slender as possible. The oxygen bottles are stored in bundles of two or four and are easily accessible under deck covers, protected by fairings. The bundles are exchangeable or the cylinders can be recharged while remaining on the submarine. The dinghy is easily accessible for rescue or normal use. It can be inflated by high-pressure air tanks.



By removing the sail house for transportation, it is possible to open the aft superstructure completely. Doing this creates twice as much deck space and makes it easier to dismantle the tower. Forward of the superstructure is the cockpit, which gives the pilots excellent all-round visibility. The large plastic viewports are made of acrylic plastic. If the viewport is removed it is possible to change the diesel engine or the electrical equipment completely for its five-year service.
